This week, I'd like to announce the publication of my second book, "Fill a Bucket: A Guide to Daily Happiness for Young Children"

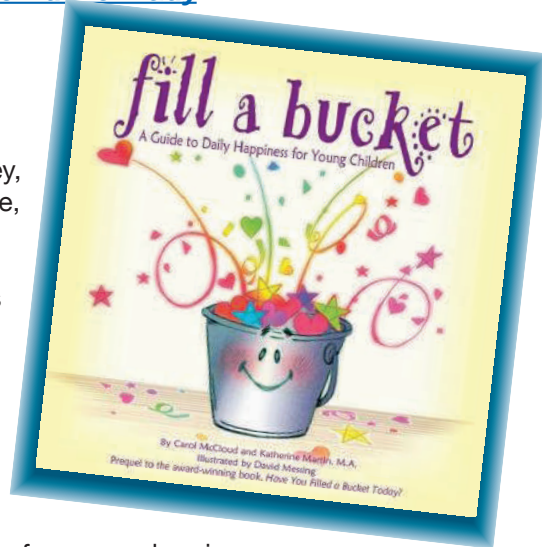
