Lid Lesson #2

1. Collect enough small plastic containers complete with lids for each student. (Gordon’s Food Service has sleeves of cups and lids that will work.)
2. Have the children decorate these as their own personal buckets and lids.



3. Make construction paper or pipe cleaner handles.

4. Talk about how your bucket gets filled and how it gets emptied.

5. Talk about why a lid might be necessary on your bucket.

6. Have the children keep their bucket with lid on the corner of their desk to help remind them to always protect their bucket.
